REDi HCC COVID-19 Situation Report #45

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Situation Summary

The REDi Healthcare Coalition remains activated in response to the 2019 novel Coronavirus (COVID-19). This report is intended to provide essential information about affected healthcare providers to create situational awareness and support a coordinated response. This report should be considered a resource for information from the REDi Situational Awareness Response Process, REDi Resource Coordination Process, WATrac, and WA Health survey.

Today, the REDi HCC surveyed eastern Washington hospitals, hospice, long-term care, skilled nursing, ambulatory surgical centers, outpatient clinics, and urgent care facilities through the <u>Situational</u> <u>Awareness Response Process</u> (<u>SARP</u>). Results of this survey indicate that most healthcare facilities are continuing to experience a shortage of resources despite support with resource coordination from REDi, local health jurisdictions and the state Department of Health. Data provided through the SARP survey to track the operating conditions for space, staff, and resources/supplies of healthcare facilities is being reviewed at the state level to help determine which phase Washington state is in as a whole. As of May 19, 2020, in coordination with the Washington State Hospital Association (WSHA), the Department of Health (DOH), WA Healthcare Response Management Team, and the three WA Healthcare Coalitions there was consensus that, we as a whole state, are currently in a *contingency care phase*.

In accordance with the Governor's Proclamation 20-24.1 Reducing Restrictions on, and Safe Expansion of, Non-Urgent Medical and Dental Procedures, the Healthcare Coalitions have been tasked with tracking the ongoing status of healthcare according to the three standards of care:

- **Conventional capacity definition**: The spaces, staff, and supplies (resources) used are consistent with daily practices within the institution.
 - Conventional Care Phase All appropriate clinical care can be provided.
- **Contingency capacity definition**: The spaces, staff, and supplies used are not consistent with daily practices but provide care that is functionally equivalent to usual patient care.
 - Contingency Care Phase All appropriate clinical care can be provided so long as there is sufficient access to PPE and, for hospitals, surge capacity is at least 20%.
- **Crisis capacity definition**: Adaptive spaces, staff and supplies used are not consistent with usual standards of care but provide sufficiency of care in the context of a catastrophic disaster (i.e. Provide the best possible care to patients given the circumstances and resources available).
 - Crisis Care Phase All emergent and urgent care shall be provided; elective care, that the postponement of which for more than 90 days would, in the judgement of the clinician, cause harm; the full suite of family planning services and procedures, newborn care, infant and pediatric vaccinations, and other preventive care, such as annual flu vaccinations, can continue.

The 20-24.1 proclamation highlighted that each health care or dental facility must develop an expansion/contraction of care plan that is congruent with the COVID-19 assessment described above. These care plans should be operationalized based on the standards of care that are in effect in the health care facility's geography as determined by that region's emergency HealthCare Coalition.

On Friday, May 29th, Governor Inslee <u>announced</u> the <u>transition</u> from the Stay home, Stay Healthy order to the <u>Safe Start — Washington's Phased Reopening plan</u> beginning Monday, June 1st, 2020. The Safe Start plan means Washington state will <u>reopen in phases on a county-by-county basis</u>. With this new approach, counties will have more flexibility to demonstrate they can safely allow additional economic activity based on targeted metrics and a holistic review of their COVID-19 activity and ability to respond. Metrics include COVID-19 activity, healthcare system readiness, testing, case and contact investigations, and protecting high-risk populations.

The HCC will continue to track healthcare system readiness metrics using daily <u>WA Health survey data</u> that is currently displayed by county. Adequate bed capacity, staffing and supplies in the healthcare system to handle a surge in COVID cases will be measured by % of licensed beds occupied by patients (hospital census relative to licensed beds) and % of licensed beds occupied by suspected and confirmed COVID-19 patients. Availability of PPE and ventilators will also be considered. 
On June 4th, the REDi HCC queried 271 healthcare organizations in and around eastern Washington through the <u>REDi HCC Resource Coordination Process</u> (RCP). The query was for medical supplies requested by a clinic that had submitted ICS 213 Resource Request forms through the RCP for over 10,000 medical items (Surgical Earloop, level III masks and N95 masks). Of the 37 responses to the query, one partner indicated an ability and willingness to share resources in partial fulfilment of the requested items. All organizations with urgent healthcare resource needs should also submit their <u>ICS</u> 213 RR's to their Local Health Jurisdiction (public health) in alignment with the <u>Washington State</u>

<u>Resource Request Process</u>. This Thursday, REDi will query for requested resources that healthcare partners have submitted since June 4th.

As of April 23, 2020, WA DOH is asking healthcare to use their PPE in the yellow zone (contingency) since there is not enough in the state for healthcare to use their PPE in the standard way. REDi HCC is continuing to share CDC guidance on use of PPE, including strategies for optimizing use of PPE, as well as WA DOH new resources on conservation as well as prioritization of allocation.


WA Health Findings

WA Health is a new data collection platform launched by the Washington State Department of Health. The platform is meant to replace the Washington State Hospital Resource Tracker as the main source of information regarding the current status of hospital equipment, supplies, and COVID-19 patient status as hospitals continue to be impacted by the COVID-19 pandemic. Hospitals are asked to report daily. The information reported here by REDi is that found in WA Health on the day of the report, as of 12:00 pm.




% and Number of COVID Patients by Catchment Area


COVID positive patients




% of Licensed Beds Occupied by Patients by County

Comparing Crisis Standards of Care from REDi Situational Awareness Response Survey to Hospitals

Of the hospitals that answered the REDi Situational Awareness Survey on 06/09/2020, 32% indicated operating at the conventional level, 68% in contingency, and no hospitals reported being in crisis for resources. 96% indicated operating in conventional status for space, 4% (one hospital) indicated operating in contingency, and no hospitals indicated being in crisis. Regarding staff, 100% of hospitals reported operating in conventional status.




REDi Situational Awareness Response Survey Findings

This survey is administered by the REDi HCC to hospitals, hospice, long-term care, skilled nursing, ambulatory surgical centers, outpatient clinics, and urgent care facilities. This survey provides the most accurate status of our healthcare partner's capacity, resources, and staffing. These percentages are based on the 52 agencies that responded today and only represent this sample. These percentages should not be compared to previous samples, as sample size and respondents vary.




- Conventional
 - 79% of all agencies have implemented their incident command, emergency operations, or medical surge plan.
 - 100% of all agencies have implemented visitor restrictions and PPE conservation.
 - 60% of all agencies are reporting contingency for current resources (figure 3 above) citing low supply of all PPE, mostly N95s. Agencies also reported conserving and reusing PPE as appropriate.

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• 12% of all agencies reported contingency status regarding current staffing (figure 4 above) due to staff reassignment and general staff shortages.

• 10% of all agencies reported contingency status regarding current space (figure 5 above), citing spaces being utilized for isolation units.

Impacts by Catchment Area

<u>Spokane</u>

- 6% of agencies reported contingency status for current space.
- 9% of agencies are reporting contingency for current staff.
- 58% of agencies are reporting contingency status regarding current resources (mostly N95s) and conservation measures are in place for most agencies.

<u>Wenatchee</u>

- 10% of agencies (one agency) reported contingency status for current space.
- 100% of agencies reported *conventional* status for current staff.
- 60% of agencies are reporting a contingency for current resources, with agencies citing conserving PPE as appropriate.

Tri-Cities

- 22% of agencies reported contingency status for current space.
- 33% of agencies reported contingency for current staff.
- 67% of agencies are reporting a contingency for current resources, with agencies citing overall PPE shortages and continued conservation of PPE
